

Calogero Mauceri was born in Menfi (Agrigento) on August 26, 1962. He is a full member of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers. He earned a degree in Law from the University of Palermo and is enrolled in the board of solicitors.



He began his career in the Public Administration by public competition in 1989 and, since 2001, he has been General Manager of the members of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, where he has continuously held positions of Head of Department/Head of Independent Office since 2006.

He is currently Head of the Department for Public Works, Housing and Urban Policies, Water Infrastructure and Human and Instrumental Resources of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport since January 25, 2023.

He has been President of the Observatory for the construction of the Turin-Lyon railway line since February 22, 2022 and Extraordinary Governmental Commissioner for the Italian section of the Turin-Lyon high capacity/high speed line since August 5, 2021.

He has been the Extraordinary Governmental Commissioner for the Genoa Railway Node, the Giovi Third Pass, the "Alessandria Smistamento" station since December 20, 2019.

He was an effective member of the Board of Auditors of Public Entities from 2007 to 2021.

He served on the General Assembly of the Higher Council of Public Works as an effective member from 2007 to 2012.

In the past he was also President of the Technical Committee for overcoming the emergency in the Venice lagoon relating to polluted sediments in large navigation channels from 2007 to 2012 and Extraordinary Commissioner of the Italian Registry of Dams from 2003 to 2004.

Enrolled in the Arbitration Chamber board at the Supervisory Authority on Public Contracts first and then in ANAC.

Chairman of public works commissions and Chairman of public works and public investment testing commissions.

Member of Committees and Study Groups, including the Commission for the preparation of the statute scheme and the ANAS concession agreement scheme.

Acting commissioner for the adoption of measures for the enforcement of res judicata in matters of public works, contracts with the Public Administration, determination of rates for motorway concessions.

Lecturer at the Higher School of Economics and Finance on issues of Administrative Law and Constitutional Law from 2003 to 2012.
